

**SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT FOR
EDWARD D. JONES & CO EMPLOYEE HEALTH & WELFARE PROGRAM**

This is a summary of the annual report of the Edward D. Jones & Co Employee Health & Welfare Program (the "Plan") (Employer Identification Number 43-0345811, Plan Number 501), for the plan year 01/01/2024 through 12/31/2024. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Not all recipients of this document are participants in all Plan options described below.

The Plan has self-insured and insured options. The self-insured medical, dental and vision claims administration is delegated to Anthem, Express Scripts, Lantern, Delta Dental of Missouri, and Vision Service Plan.

Insurance Information

The insured options are provided through insurance contracts, to pay certain claims incurred under the terms of the contracts. The Plan's insured options are through contracts with Hawaii Medical Service Association to pay certain health and prescription drugs and Metropolitan Life Insurance Company for , life insurance, long-term disability, accidental death and dismemberment and business travel accident claims incurred under the terms of the Plan. The total premiums paid for the Plan year ending 12/31/2024 were \$43,245,516.

SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT FOR EDWARD D. JONES & CO. PROFIT SHARING AND 401(K) PLAN

This is a summary of the annual report Form 5500 Annual Return/Report of Employee Benefit Plan of Edward D. Jones & Co. Profit Sharing And 401(k) Plan and Employer Identification Number 43-0345811/Plan Number 001 for the plan year 01/01/2024 through 12/31/2024. The Form 5500 annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA). Your plan is a single employer, defined contribution plan with the following characteristics: profit sharing, ERISA section 404(c), total participant-directed account, code section 401(k) feature, code section 401(m) arrangement, 401(k) or 403(b) plan that provides for automatic enrollment, total or partial participant-directed account, covered by self-employed individuals, member of a controlled group.

Basic Financial Statement

Benefits under the plan are provided by insurance contracts and a trust fund. Plan expenses were \$890,214,405. These expenses included \$1,245,386 in administrative expenses and \$888,969,065 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries, and -\$46 in other expenses. A total of 58392 persons were participants in or beneficiaries of the plan at the end of the plan year, although not all of these persons had yet earned the right to receive benefits.

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$12,367,926,240 as of the end of the plan year, compared to \$10,594,310,630 as of the beginning of the plan year. During the plan year the plan experienced a change in its net assets of \$1,773,615,610. This change includes unrealized appreciation or depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or the cost of assets acquired during the year. The plan had total income of \$2,663,830,015, including employer contributions of \$427,680,802, employee contributions of \$571,506,162, other contributions/other income of \$84,574,659, and earnings from investments of \$1,580,068,392.
